# Regulations of using free wireless Internet service – HotSpot in the Treblinka Museum. The Nazi German Extermination and Forced Labour Camp (1941-1944)

§ 1

### Scope and purpose

- 1. The Treblinka Museum. The Nazi German Extermination and Forced Labour Camp (1941-1944) (further called **the Museum**) provides to the visitors of the Museum (further called **the Visitors**) access to the Wi-Fi network for the purpose of using the Internet connection.
- 2. The access to the Wi-Fi network is provided free of charge, is non-commercial and is available only in the area of Parking of the Museum.
- 3. Museum does not provide the technical assistance for the visitors.
- 4. Due to the safety reasons the Museum does not guarantee the access to all of the network services
- 5. Every Visitor is allowed to use the Wi-Fi network, under the condition of applying to the following Regulations.
- 6. The network traffic is being monitored and archived for the purposes of managing the Museum's statutory responsibilities.

§ 2

## Restrictions and exemptions from liability

- 1. The Museum is not responsible for interruptions in the Internet access, lower bandwidth (especially related to maintenance works or contingencies) and other technical conditions of the network.
- 2. Accepting the following Regulations is equivalent to accessing the network. The Visitors are allowed to repeatedly connect with the Wi-Fi.
- 3. The Museum is not responsible for the damage incurred as a result of a usage of Wi-Fi or services available through the Wi-Fi connection as well as damage to IT equipment and software, loss or disclosure of data or other consequences of using the service.
- 4. The Museum is not responsible for the data collected or transferred by the Visitors.
- 5. The Museum is not responsible for the Visitors' unauthorized use of items protected by intellectual property laws or other consequences of the non-compliance with the law.

§ 3

### Visitor's obligations and liabilities

- 1. The Wi-Fi network is used at the sole risk and responsibility of the Visitors.
- 2. The Visitor may use the Wi-Fi under the condition that he/she accepts and complies to the terms and conditions contained in these regulations.
- 3. Visitors who access the Wi-Fi connection are obliged to:
  - a. comply with the general legislations,
  - b. refrain from uploading and sharing illegal content,
  - c. secure their devices from unauthorized accessed and have an anti-virus software.

- 4. Visitors are not allowed to take actions which may negatively affect the functioning of the Wi-Fi network and devices of other visitors. Visitors are also not allowed to take any activities violating the law such as:
  - a. gaining unauthorized access to system resources,
  - b. trying to breach the safeguards applied to the wireless connection (changing the IP address, tunneling etc.),
  - c. sharing the Internet connection with other entities via the use of telecommunication devices (e.g. routers),
  - d. sharing and downloading copyrighted material and content that violates the law (racist, fascist, pornographic etc.),
  - e. uploading and sharing content which may violate personal goods of another person,
  - f. conducting any other activities which may be a potential threat to the functioning of the network or breaking the law.
- 5. The Visitors are solely responsible for the manner in which they use the Wi-Fi connection, including content and the content of data sent with regard to criminal liability for illegal activities.

§ 4

## **General provisions**

- 1. Ignorance of the those Regulations does not exempt the Visitors from the liability for its violation. Accepting the regulations is equivalent to being acquainted with them.
- 2. In case of violation of the existing Regulations by the Visitor, the Museum reserves the right to block the Visitors' access to Wi-Fi network.
- 3. The Museum reserves the right to restrict access to selected content and services on the internet.
- 4. The Regulations are available on the website www.treblinka-muzeum.eu and at the site of Museum Treblinka: Wólka Okrąglik 115, 08-330 Kosów Lacki.
- 5. The Museum reserves the right to make changes to these regulations at any time.
- 6. The Regulations come into force on 01.12.2018.
